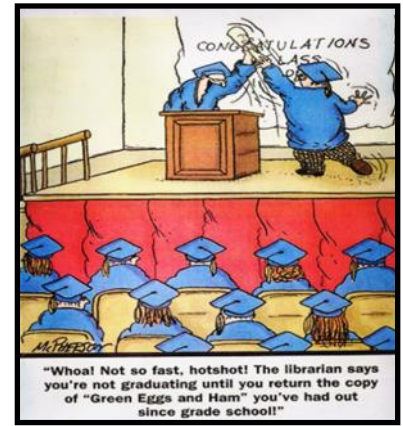

CMAS Testing Update

This spring, Poudre School District will administer statewide assessments. These tests provide valuable information for our school and teachers, who use the data to understand where students are in their learning and tailor instruction accordingly. The district also uses these results to measure overall student academic progress and identify opportunities for improvement.

There are discussions about assessments happening at the state and federal levels during this COVID-19 era, and we will update you if our current plans change as a result.

Our school's testing schedule is as follows:

Juniors:

- SAT exam, Tues, April 13, 2021
- CMAS Science, Wed, April 14, 2021

Sophomores:

- PSAT 10 exam, Wed, April 14, 2021

Freshmen:

- PSAT 9 exam, Wed, April 14, 2021

Like in years past, students will take assessments at school. We recommend that they bring a book with them so they can read it if they finish early.

To excuse your student from state assessments, you may complete a Parent Excusal form digitally by logging into [ParentVUE](#) and accessing Services Tracker. Instructions and screenshots on how to do this can be found at <https://techportal.psdschools.org/node/2603>. Please note that **you will need to fill out a form for each subject area**. You may also print a PDF version of the "2020-21 Opt Out of State Testing Form" or pick one up at school and return it to your school. Forms are available in [English](#), [Spanish](#) and [Arabic](#).

If you decide to opt out, you may choose to keep them home during the testing block and bring them to school after the testing block at 10:50am. If you send them to school like normal, we will provide a place for them to go and work during testing. Absences will be excused.

If your child is ill on a testing day, they should not come to school and follow the [Return to Learn guidelines](#) or [PSD COVID-19 protocols](#). Families may contact us to discuss makeup options.

Frequently Asked Questions (to support schools to answer family questions/do not send with the letter)

How do I excuse my student from state assessments (CMAS, PSAT, SAT, etc.) this spring? *If you decide to opt out, we encourage you to keep your student home on our scheduled testing days. Due to COVID-19 protocols, students who are opted out of tests but come to school will still sit with their classmates during the testing sessions, so we do not mix cohorts. They may sit quietly or read a book, according to state guidelines. [More information >>](#)*

If I choose to excuse my student from state assessments (e.g. CMAS), will that affect their course or program placement? *PSD uses CMAS assessment scores as one way to determine a student’s performance level, which may make them eligible for additional academic supports or a program such as [Gifted and Talented](#).*

How many hours do students spend taking assessments? (Asked another way: How many hours is my student “not being taught?”) *The following is a resource from the Colorado Department of Education that shows the amount of time for each test. [More information >>](#)*

Tests are broken down into individual sessions lasting between 50 and about 110 minutes

***Students who elect to take the additional optional essay will add about an hour to their SAT testing time, including breaks.*

Why is PSD administering state assessments after the Board of Education passed a resolution in January asking for statewide tests to be paused this school year? *The Board of Education did in January approve a resolution supporting the suspension of CMAS testing for this school year for several reasons, including that the services school districts across Colorado have been severely disrupted because of COVID-19. That said, President Joe Biden communicated on Feb. 22, 2021 update about assessments, accountability and reporting requirements for this school year. Based on President Biden's communication, we understand the importance of gathering data so we can identify each student's instructional needs and monitor the effectiveness of our teacher's work with them. Many things have changed throughout the pandemic, and we have shifted as those changes have occurred. This is just another example of that. CMAS Testing Update

Estimadas familias de Poudre HS:

En esta primavera, los estudiantes del Distrito Escolar Poudre (PSD, por sus siglas en inglés) tomarán las evaluaciones estatales. Estas pruebas brindan datos valiosos para nuestra escuela y los maestros, los cuales utilizan los resultados para informarse sobre cuánto han aprendido los estudiantes y adaptar la instrucción de manera apropiada. El Distrito también usa estos resultados para medir el progreso académico general de los estudiantes, e identificar oportunidades para un mejoramiento.

En la actualidad se está analizando a nivel estatal y federal si dichas evaluaciones se llevarán a cabo en estos tiempos de la COVID-19; les informaremos en caso de que nuestros planes cambien.

Al igual que en años anteriores, los estudiantes tomarán las evaluaciones en la escuela. Les recomendamos que traigan un libro para leer, si terminan pronto.

Si no desean que su estudiante tome las evaluaciones estatales, pueden llenar el Formulario de Exclusión de las Evaluaciones Estatales, de manera digital, a través de [ParentVUE](#) utilizando Services Tracker. Las instrucciones para llenar el formulario en mención se pueden encontrar [aquí](#) (para leerlas en español, hagan clic en “Select Language” [Seleccionar el idioma], que está situado en la barra superior verde, y buscar “Spanish” [español]). Tengan presente que deberán llenar un formulario para cada área temática. También pueden imprimir una versión en PDF del "Formulario de Exclusión de las Evaluaciones Estatales - Año académico 2020-21" y entregarlo a su escuela. Los formularios están disponibles en [inglés](#), [español](#) y [árabe](#).

Si deciden que su estudiante no participe en las evaluaciones, les sugerimos que su estudiante no venga a la escuela en los días en que se hayan programado las pruebas. Sus ausencias serán justificadas. Debido a los protocolos de la COVID-19, los estudiantes que se excluyan de las pruebas, pero que vengan a la escuela, tendrán que sentarse con sus compañeros de clase durante las sesiones de la prueba, con la finalidad de no mezclar distintos grupos de estudiantes. De acuerdo con las pautas estatales, pueden sentarse en silencio o leer un libro.

Si su estudiante se enferma el día de la prueba, debe quedarse en casa y seguir las pautas de [Regreso al Aprendizaje \(Return to Learn\)](#) o [los protocolos del PSD con respecto a la COVID-19 \(PSD COVID-19 protocols\)](#). Las familias pueden contactarnos acerca de las opciones para tomar las pruebas en otra fecha.

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جدول اختبارات مدرستنا هو كما يلي:

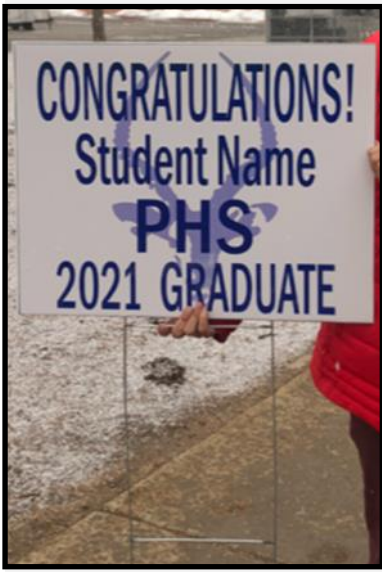

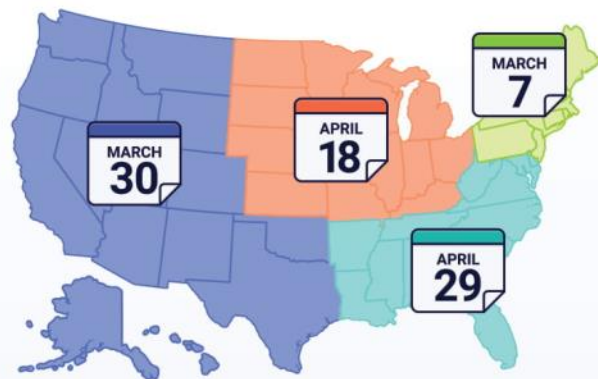

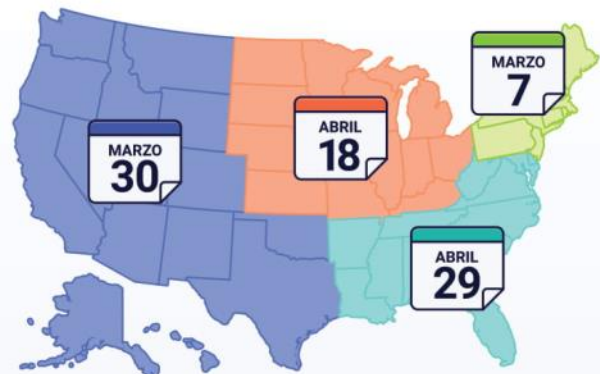
