Back to School The most important thing for you to know as you plan and consider the upcoming school year, is that we are excited to resume teaching, learning, and working with our students. And, we are committed to ensuring the safety and health of our students, staff, and families. We will be following the guidance for K-12 schools as outlined by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, and we will adjust our practices as needed. The current PSD health and safety protocols will be outlined in this newsletter.

Now, more than ever, we are reminded that as a school community, "I am who I am because of who we are." Thank you for your patience and flexibility as we work together to support a safe return to the academic school year.

Poudre Protocols for Safety

In order for us to keep one another safe, we will have some safety guidelines we must follow. This is the ultimate Ubuntu--I am who I am because of who we are. We are Poudre!

Health guidelines are continually changing, so we will do our best to communicate our practices as soon as we are informed by the Superintendent. Currently, the protocols below are being enforced:

- PSD is strongly encouraging but not requiring staff or students to get COVID-19 vaccines. Those who are fully vaccinated (14 days from their last dose) will not be quarantined if exposed.
- PSD is a mask-friendly district. Masks are highly recommended and supported for people who are unvaccinated, following Colorado's current public health order.
 PSD supports those who choose to wear masks. Depending on outbreaks or other high-risk activities, masks may be required indoors.
- Masks are required for all individuals on buses under federal order.
- We will continue hand washing and frequent cleaning.
- Individuals are encouraged to remain at least 3 feet away from non-household contacts when possible.
- Continue to self-monitor; anyone experiencing symptoms should stay home. PSD will follow CDPHE's updatedReturn to Learn guidance.
- When outbreaks occur, PSD will work with LCDHE to determine the appropriate response. This could include masks indoors, additional distancing, testing, contact tracing and quarantining.
- PHS staff will make use of outdoor spaces and ventilation, such as opening windows, if possible, and use of box fans.

Carrying School Supplies:

- We will not be assigning lockers to all students. However, if a student opts to have a locker, we will assign the student one during Fall Check-in.
- If a student needs a backpack, we have some available in the counseling office, along with other school supplies.

Off periods:

If a student has an off-period, they have a few options for where they can go during the period:

- 1. They may leave campus
- 2. They may go to the Media Center
- 3. They may go to the Commons

End of Day Dismissal:

Students are encouraged to leave campus immediately, unless they have a scheduled appointment with a staff member or are participating in athletics.

2021-2022 Schedule

Parents and students.

We are excited to announce our school has adopted a hybrid-block schedule, meaning some classes will meet daily and other classes will meet every other day. This schedule was created after piloting the full block schedule last year and getting feedback from staff, students and parents. This hybrid-block is incredibly flexible in that we are able to embrace the benefits of a 4x4 block, which include fewer classes for students to juggle, fewer transitions within the day, smaller student caseloads for teachers, and more frequent opportunities for credit recovery and/or acceleration. In the hybrid, we will also have some classes that meet every other day over a longer period of time--either the full semester or year. These classes will be noted as (A/B) on a student's schedule. This A/B schedule meets the needs of classes that have end-of-year external assessments or need more time for reading, writing or research.



Late Start and Collaboration:



Student Drivers


ATTENTION STUDENT DRIVERS.

Schedule Repair Requests

Counselors are working hard to finalize student schedules for the fall 2021 and we wanted to share the process for making schedule repairs.

Student schedules will be available to view starting on August 9th through StudentVue and ParentVue.

Schedule repairs will be offered to students **August 10-20**. The most efficient way to request a schedule repairs is to email your counselor directly. Due to the large volume of emails we receive this time of year, please allow for 2 days for a reply.

Schedule repairs will only be granted for the following reasons:

- Duplicate classes (ex: Two Chemistry classes)
- Class I did not register for (and was not listed as an alternate class)
- Incorrect level placement
- Completed coursework over the summer
- Not meeting a graduation requirement with my current schedule (SENIORS only)
- Want to drop a class (you must have a minimum of 3 classes each quarter)
- Missing a prerequisite for a course that is currently on my schedule

***11th and 12th grade students must take a minimum of 60 credits, 9th and 10th grade students must take a minimum of 70 credits.

Information on SMS text messaging and Short Codes:

SMS stands for Short Message Service and is commonly referred to as a "text message". Most cell phones support this type of text messaging. Our notification provider, SchoolMessenger, uses a true SMS protocol developed by the telecommunications industry specifically for mass text messaging, referred to as "short code" texting. This method is fast, secure and highly reliable because it is strictly regulated by the wireless carriers and only allows access to approved providers. If you've ever sent a text vote for a TV show to a number like 46999, you have used short code texting.



Getting Started with ParentVUE

What is the ParentVUE Portal?

The ParentVUE portal allows parents/guardians to view their student's school information. The information is accessed directly from the student information system Synergy SIS.

While the website is accessible over the Internet, access is secured via logon and password. Parents can only see information about their students, and cannot see the records for other students. Parents may only view the information and cannot make changes to the student's records.








Activating Your account

- Read through the Privacy Statement and click the "I Accept" button to agree to the privacy agreement.
- Type your First Name, Last Name and Activation Key exactly as they are stated in the email you received.
- 3. You will be asked to change your user name and password. Passwords are case sensitive and must consist of at least one number and at least one letter, and must be a minimum of 6 characters in length. Use the primary email provided in the email sent. Click "Complete Account Activation".

Note: The activation process only needs to be completed once. However, if you have more than one child you will not have access to view his/her information until the Education Rights is set by the school for each child. For further assistance, please contact your child's school.





Eligibility

Eligibility will be checked at the beginning of each season. Fall eligibility is determined in August based on spring semester grades earned. Athletes identified as failing two or more classes during spring semester will be ineligible for fall sports until the second week in October.

PHS checks athletic eligibility on a weekly basis. Athletes identified as failing two or more classes will be declared ineligible and will lose one week of eligibility beginning on the following Monday through Saturday.


