Reasons for late testing:

Reasons for which late testing (using an alternate form of the exam) will and will not be allowed are listed below. Only those students affected by the conflict may test late; all other students must test on the regularly scheduled date. Some circumstances are generally beyond the control of school officials and students. In such cases, there will be no additional fee for using an alternate form of the exam.

Reasons for late testing:

- Conflict with International Baccalaureate (IB) exam
- Religious holiday/observance
- Three or more AP Exams on same date
- Two AP Exams on same date and time

Please visit the College Board's website to enroll your AP Courses if you have not already done so. **Exams will only be ordered if they are enrolled with the College Board AND paid for through Total Registration.** Please visit [MyAP.CollegeBoard.org](http://MyAP.CollegeBoard.org) and log in with your existing College Board account used for previous AP, PSAT or SAT exams or create a new account if you do not have an existing College Board Account. You will be prompted to enter your class **JOIN CODE**. You will get the code from your teacher.
