 2. Completed, signed copy of "ASCENT CE Eligibility Verification Form 2023 – 2024"
 3. Unofficial copy of your college transcripts (CU Succeeds, CSU, AIMS, FRCC, etc.)
 4. Unofficial copy of your PSD transcript
 5. Copy of AP scores that were received directly from [College Board](#) (required only if you're using any AP scores for ASCENT eligibility)
