## **Spring Testing**

Each spring students are required by the Colorado Department of Education to take a test in reading, writing, math and science.

PHS will host **REMOTE LEARNING DAYS** on these testing days: **Wednesday**, **April 16th** and **Thursday**, **April 17**, **2025**. This means that students will not attend class at PHS but instead log into Google Classroom from home and complete their assignments posted online. Only students who are testing will be allowed on campus on those dates.

Please note that there is **no late start** on Wednesday, April 16, 2025.

There is **no school** on Friday, April 18th, 2025.

#### WHO TAKES A TEST? WHICH TEST DO THEY TAKE?

- Seniors do not take any exams other than those seniors who choose to take the Seal of Biliteracy exam on Thursday, April 17th.
- Juniors will take the CMAS Science exam on Wednesday, April 16th and the SAT exam on Thursday, April 17th.
- Sophomores will take the PSAT 10 exam on Wednesday, April 16th.
- Freshmen will take the PSAT 9 exam on Wednesday, April 16th.

This is a great opportunity for your student to either practice test taking or hone their skills and improve their scores. This test will also allow you to evaluate your academic growth from freshman year up to and beyond junior year.

#### HOW LONG IS THE TEST?

- Seniors / Seal of Biliteracy / 3 hours
- Juniors / CMAS Science / 2 hours
- Juniors / SAT / 3 hours
- Sophomores / PSAT 10 / 2 hours and 30 minutes
- Freshmen / PSAT 9 / 2 hours and 30 minutes

#### HOW DO I OPT MY STUDENT OUT OF THE TEST?

- 1. Log into ParentVue.
- 2. Select your student.
- 3. Select PSD Forms and Applications.
- 4. Select Forms.
- 5. Select the test you would like to opt out of.

You can also print and sign a paper copy of the exempt form online at https://www.psdschools.org/academics/student-outcomes/district-stateassessments/excusing-students-state-assessments. Hand in opt out forms to school counseling department.

Exams begin promptly at 9:05 am. Students are to bring their school laptop fully charged. We encourage parents to pick up their students after the exam on the testing day.

#### 2024-25 State Testing Opt-Out Form

The Colorado Measures of Academic Success (CMAS) is an assessment system designed to measure student mastery of the Colorado Academic Standards. CMAS includes testing for English Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies in grades 3 - 8. Students participate in PSAT preparatory exams in grades 9 - 10 and the SAT college entrance exam and CMAS Science in grade 11. Students who qualify for alternate assessments are those with significant cognitive disabilities for whom general state assessments are not appropriate. Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) is the alternate assessment for English Language Arts and Math for students in grades 3 - 11. The Colorado Alternate assessment (CoAlt) is the alternate assessment for Science and Social Studies.

In December of 2009, Colorado adopted revised academic content standards progressing from early school readiness to postsecondary competencies reflective of both workforce readiness and 21<sup>st</sup> century skills. Student progress toward these outcomes is measured through results from CMAS, PSAT, and SAT, which provide information to teachers as they incorporate the content standards in their daily instruction. These results are also used for school and district accountability.

By opting out, I recognize that I will not receive results of my child's achievement and growth as measured by these assessments. I also understand that educators use these results for instructional planning, class placement, and academic screening, and that this information will not be available to my child's educators.





## **Attention Current 9th Grade Students & Families**

High school credit earned in middle school.

When a student transitions from middle school to high school, students who completed qualifying high school credit earning courses while in middle school, will see these courses and grades included on their high school course history in Student VUE/ Parent VUE.

These credits and grades are included in a student 's high school transcript and grade point average. Students/Parents may choose to NOT receive HS credit for qualifying middle school courses and to NOT have them calculated in the high school GPA. Please review and consult with the student 's high school courselor as needed.

The window for declining HS credit begins the FIRST DAY of a student 's ninth grade school year and ends the LAST DAY of a student 's ninth grade school year.



While this can make a more entertaining ride, please remember that it is important to hear cars and other things around you. Consider using ear buds that allow noise around you or only using one.


## **Support the Boys' Basketball Program**


