



PSAT

2024 PSAT NMSQT Test (Pre-SAT) — October 23rd WHO: Primarily for any 11th grader considering college after high school, but 10th graders may also take it. Priority is given to 11th graders, so 10th graders will be wait-listed. WHY: Taking the PSAT can make 11th graders eligible for the National Merit Scholarship and is excellent preparation for the SAT college entrance exam. WHEN: Wednesday, October 23 Check-in 8:15am Testing 8:30am – 12:30pm

WHERE: Main Gym

REQUIRED: Regular and Late Registration takes place with Poudre's cashier, Mrs. Malm. Registration for the PSAT will take place Sept. 6 through Oct. 7, 2024 until 4:00pm. The registration fee is \$20.00. It is to your advantage to register for the PSAT as soon as possible so that you can use the materials you will receive when you register to prepare for the exam. Late registrations will be available on a space available basis.

The opportunity to register for the PSAT ends on Oct. 7 at 4:00pm.



PHS Winter Sports 2024-25



Orange "Permit to Practice" cards will be issued for the winter season starting Monday October 21st. Monday thru Friday at Mrs. Smith's Desk in the front office. You must have an orange card to start tryouts.

To receive an <u>Orange Card</u>, submit your physical to Mrs. Smith starting Oct. 21st, proof of payment and complete online registration at <u>https://www.psdathletics.org</u> Select High School, then HS online sports registration Online Registration opens Oct. 21st and closes on Nov 7th Schedules can be found at www.frontrangeleague.org

Athletic Participation Fee:

<u>PHS Students</u> \$205.00 per sport no family max <u>Charter/ Home or Private School Students</u> \$305.00 per sport no family max

Payment of athletic fee is required to receive an Orange Card. YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIAPTE IF YOUR FEE IS NOT PAID IN FULL BEFORE TRYOUTS! If a student athlete is not offered a spot on a team, the athletic fee will be reimbursed in full. Students who meet federal guidelines for the free or reduced lunch program will have the participation fee waived.

Eligibility

Eligibility will be checked at the beginning of each season. Eligibility is determined based on previous semester grades earned. Athletes identified as failing two or more classes during the previous semester will be ineligible for sports until the regain date. All sports have different regain dates.

PHS checks athletic eligibility on a weekly basis. Athletes identified as failing two or more classes will be declared ineligible and will lose one week of eligibility beginning on the following Monday through Saturday. 


Cadet Of The Month


