

#### **PSD's CELL PHONE GUIDELINES**

All PK-8 schools are **cellphone free zones from bell to bell**. Students must keep phones, headphones, and other electronic accessories out of sight and on silent unless approved by an administrator or specified in an IEP, 504 plan, or Health Care Action Plan. In grades 9-12, devices must be put away during class and instructional time but may be used during passing periods, off periods, lunch, before and after school, or for approved academic activities. #### **POUDRE HIGH SCHOOL CELL PHONE POLICY**

Impalas get to disconnect from technology and reconnect with themselves and others!

#### No cell phones - full class period:

- Cell phones silenced and out of sight
- > Smartwatches, iPads, etc. silenced
- ➤ No use of airpods/wireless headphones headphones may be plugged into school-issued laptops
- \*Unless specifically identified in an IEP, 504, or Health Care Action Plan

#### Breaks during class:

➤ No cell phone use unless specifically identified in an IEP, 504, or Health Care Action Plan

#### Cell phones allowed:

- > For academic activities with approved curriculum by administration
- > During passing periods, lunch, off periods, before and after school
- > Specifically identified in an IEP, 504, or Health Care Action Plan

#### Cell phone violation - three tiered response:

- > 1st offense: teacher will take the cell phone/earbuds for the entirety of the class period and they will be returned at the end of the class period by the teacher.
- > 2nd offense: teacher will take cell phone/earbuds to Mr. Holley. At the end of the school day, students will pick up cell-phone/earbuds from Mr. Holley.
- > 3rd offense: teacher will take cell phone/earbuds to Mr. Holley and the student's parents/guardians will pick them up at the end of the day.
- ➤ Violations exceeding 3 in one school year will result in a co-created technology plan.
- Continued violations or refusals to turn over cell phones will result in discipline for willful disobedience.
- \*Teachers will model the cell phone policy expectation during class.
- \*Upon teacher/staff approval, a student may make a brief telephone call to a parent/guardian by stepping outside of the classroom.
- \*Parents/guardians should contact the front office if they need to contact their student during class: 970-488-6000.

#### 2025 PSAT/NMSQT

2025 PSAT/NMSQT—October 22<sup>nd</sup>

(Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test)

**WHO:** Primarily for any 11<sup>th</sup> grader considering college after high school, but 10<sup>th</sup> graders may also take it. \*Priority is given to 11<sup>th</sup> graders; 10<sup>th</sup> graders will be wait-listed.

**WHY:** Taking the PSAT can make 11<sup>th</sup> graders eligible for the National Merit Scholarship and is excellent preparation for the SAT college entrance exam.

WHEN: Wednesday, October 22, 2025 Check-in 8:30am Testing 9:00am – 1:00pm

WHERE: Main Gym

**REQUIRED:** Regular and Late Registration takes place with Poudre's cashier, Mrs. Malm. Registration for the PSAT will take place Sept. 8, 2025, through Oct. 10, 2025, until 4:00 pm. The registration fee is \$20.00. It is to your advantage to register for the PSAT as soon as possible so that you can use the materials you will receive when you register to prepare for the exam. Late registrations will be available on a space available basis.

**HURRY:** We are limited to 120 test takers!!

**NOTE:** If you have special needs or a 504 PLAN, see your counselor ASAP. Unless you've completed the necessary special accommodations application and documentation process with College Board, it is unlikely that you will be able to receive special testing accommodations.







#### **SENIOR PICTURES**

Senior pictures are due by **October 31, 2025**. We cannot guarantee late pictures will be in the book. If no picture is submitted, we will use your school picture. Senior Pictures **MUST** fit the following guidelines:

- All clothing must be appropriate and fit the PHS dress code.

- Senior Photos must be uploaded. There is no other submission process. Do NOT email them.
- **Note**: Professional photographers may request a different due date. It is the student's responsibility to check with the studio and confirm that the picture was received on time.

#### Junior-STUDY

- Register to take the ACT, SAT or both and use the NCAA Eligibility Center code "9999" as a score recipient.
- Double check to make sure that you are taking academic courses that are approved on your high school's List of NCAA Courses.
- Visit Mr. Flores in the Counseling office to request that your official transcript be sent to the NCAA Eligibility Center <u>after</u> completing your junior year.

#### Senior-GRADUATE

- Visit your account page after you register online to view your eligibility status and check for any tasks, missing information, or documents.
- Review your sports participation (amateurism) responses and request final amateurism certification beginning April 1 (for fall enrollees) or October 1 (for spring enrollees).
- After graduation, Mr. Flores will send your final transcript with proof of graduation to the NCAA Eligibility Center (1<sup>st</sup> week of June).



#### STILL NEED SCHOOL VACCINES? WE CAN HELP.

The Larimer County Department of Health & Environment is offering low- or no-cost vaccines to children (ages 4 and older) and their families who are uninsured, underinsured, or enrolled in most Medicaid plans. Vaccine clinics will be held at schools across the community to provide the following while supplies last:

- Children: All school-required vaccines
- · Adults: MMR vaccine which protects against measles
- · All eligible participants: Flu and COVID-19 vaccines

- Not eligible: Private insurance and CHP+ are not accepted at these clinics
- . What to bring: Previous vaccine records and any school-issued vaccine letters
