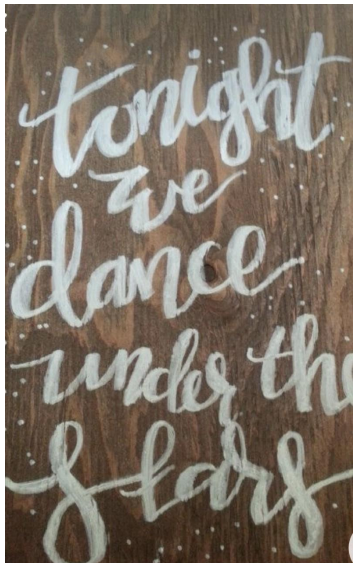

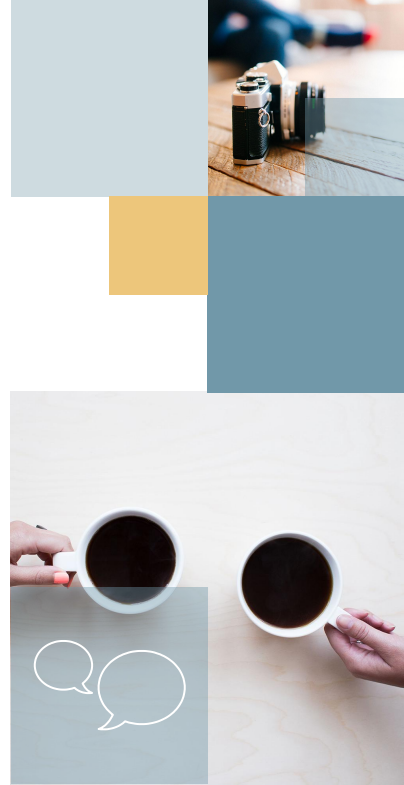




May 18-19 Big Events

- Staff member will give instructions how to enter and exit stadium


