## **PSAT**

**WHO:** Primarily for any 11th grader considering college after high school, but 10th graders may also take it. Priority is given to 11th graders, so 10th graders will be wait-listed. NOTE: Due to changes to the PSAT exam, 9th graders can no longer take it.

**WHY:** Taking the PSAT will make 11th graders eligible for the National Merit Scholarship and is excellent preparation for the SAT college entrance exam.

WHEN: Wednesday, October 12 Check-in 8:15am Testing 8:30am – 12:30pm

WHERE: Main Gym

**REQUIRED:** Regular and Late Registration takes place with Poudre's cashier, Mrs. Malm. Registration for the PSAT will take place Sept. 5 through Oct. 7, 2022, until 4:00 pm. The registration fee is \$20.00. It is to your advantage to register for the PSAT as soon as possible so that you can use the materials you will receive when you register to prepare for the exam. Late registrations will be available on a space available basis.

The opportunity to register for the PSAT ends on Oct. 7, at 4:00pm.

**HURRY:** We are limited to 100 test takers!!

**NOTE:** If you have special needs or a 504 PLAN, see your counselor ASAP. Unless you've completed the necessary special accommodations application and documentation process with College Board it is unlikely that you will be able to receive special testing accommodations!

# 2022 Colorado Free Application Days (Oct. 18-20, 2022)



#### Overview

Colorado's fifth annual Free Applications Day\$ will be held on October 18 - 20th, 2022.

If the college/university has **additional application documents** required as part of the application process (for example, high school transcripts, letters of recommendation, etc.) they can be submitted before or after Oct. 18 - 20 unless otherwise stated in their instructions.

## Instructions for Free Application Day\$ Fee Waivers by College/University

Almost all colleges and universities have application fee waivers for financial hardship during the entire year. As such, if you have a financial hardship and wish to submit your admission application before (or after) Free Application Day\$, contact the admission office at the college/university you want to apply to for more information. More information regarding this process for each college/university in Colorado will be posted soon!

#### SENIOR PICTURES

Senior pictures are due by October 21, 2022. Pictures submitted after this deadline will not be printed in the yearbook. We will replace missing pictures with ID photos, if available.

The yearbook staff reserves the right to refuse your photograph if it is inappropriate, so please make good choices and use good judgment with your submissions.

#### Senior Pictures MUST fit the following guidelines:

- \* All clothing must be appropriate and fit the PHS dress code.
- \* No animals, vehicles, or hats in senior pictures.
- \* Pictures must have a vertical orientation. Horizontal photos will be cropped or rejected.
- \* Photos should be a focused headshot. Full body/distant photos will be zoomed in or rejected.
- \* Your vertical close-up must be in a 2.5x3.5 ratio with high resolution of at least 750x1050 pixels (300 DPI).

#### Upload your image **HERE**.

Make sure to label the picture "[First][Last]SeniorPicture".

- \* Senior Photos must be uploaded. There is no other submission process. Do not bring us hard copies, disks, or flash drives.
- \* Note: Professional photographers may request a different due date. It is the student's responsibility to check with the studio and confirm that the picture was received on time.






# **Student Info Updates in ParentVUE**







